Munich is consistently ranked among Europe's safest major cities. Low violent crime, efficient police presence, and an orderly public culture make it an exceptionally comfortable destination for solo travelers of all ages. During Oktoberfest, pickpockets increase sharply — that's the one time heightened vigilance is warranted.

Munich rewards the traveler who wanders freely. The U-Bahn runs late on weekends — use it confidently.

COMMON SCAMS & HOW TO AVOID THEM

- Oktoberfest pickpockets:**
Crowded tents are prime territory. Use money belt; leave valuables at hotel.
- Tourist restaurant overcharging:**
Ask to see the menu with prices before sitting. Marienplatz area is worst.
- Fake charity collectors:**
Clipboard approach near major sights. Politely decline.
- Taxi from airport (unofficial):**
Use the S-Bahn or book via app — only licensed taxis from official rank.

HEALTH & MEDICAL

- Dial 112 for all emergencies — English widely spoken.
- LMU Klinikum and MRI hospital offer world-class care.
- Apotheke (pharmacies) are plentiful; staff speak English in central areas.
- Tap water is excellent quality throughout the city.
- EU EHIC accepted. Travel insurance still recommended.

SOLO WOMEN TRAVELERS

Munich is one of Europe's best cities for solo women travelers. It is routinely listed in top-10 European rankings for female solo safety. The café culture is friendly to solo diners; women eating or drinking alone attract zero negative attention. The only exception: Oktoberfest tents can get aggressively rowdy in the evening hours. Visit in the morning or early afternoon instead.
